

Packing list - items sorted in bundles

Valid from 1 April 2026

Items of small and large format

The packaging list applies per order/delivery and includes mailings sorted into bundles with 2- and 4-digits in the postal code. When the number of bundles sorted by 2- or 4-digits amounts to half a pallet or 300 kg for postal code areas defined in the table below, these bundles must be packed onto pallets according to the same table.

When the number of bundles sorted by 2- or 4-digits amounts to less than half a pallet or 300 kg for the above-mentioned postal code areas, the following classification applies for packing on pallets:

The bundles are distributed according to postal code areas as shown in the tables. The pallets are marked according to the information in the columns “Postcode areas” and “Address to terminal”. Marking of load carriers are available by contacting Bring customer service. Marking and addressing of bundles must be in accordance to Posten Bring AS` s conditions for packing and marking of bundles. In addition, conditions for Mail items with identical format applies.
